

# SUNDAY, MARCH 17

LUKE 22:1-5; 47-53

1 Now the festival of Unleavened Bread, which is called the Passover, was near. 2The chief priests and the scribes were looking for a way to put Jesus to death, for they were afraid of the people. 3 Then Satan entered into Judas called Iscariot, who was one of the twelve; 4he went away and conferred with the chief priests and officers of the temple police about how he might betray him to them. 5They were greatly pleased and agreed to give him money.

47 While he was still speaking, suddenly a crowd came, and the one called Judas, one of the twelve, was leading them. He approached Jesus to kiss him; 48but Jesus said to him, 'Judas, is it with a kiss that you are betraying the Son of Man?' 49When those who were around him saw what was coming, they asked, 'Lord, should we strike with the sword?' 50Then one of them struck the slave of the high priest and cut off his right ear. 51But Jesus said, 'No more of this!' And he touched his ear and healed him. 52Then Jesus said to the chief priests, the officers of the temple police, and the elders who had come for him, 'Have you come out with swords and clubs as if I were a bandit? 53When I was with you day after day in the temple, you did not lay hands on me.
